**Fiscal Analysis:** This bill requires DOE to develop and make available new guidance, training guidelines, and training materials related to the provisions of this bill. DOE anticipates the need for an additional position to help develop these resources and ensure ongoing compliance with the provisions of the bill.

DOE indicates that the agency will not be able to complete the work required by this bill to develop guidance, training guidelines, and materials, by August 1, 2026. DOE anticipates the agency can meet these requirements by January 1, 2027.

Any impact to local school divisions to implement the new training requirements or other provisions of the bill is indeterminate.

**Other:** This bill is similar to SB491 and HB836.
