**Bill Number:** HB781 **Patron:** Herring  
**Bill Title:** Constitutional amendment (voter referendum); fundamental right to reproductive freedom.

**Bill Summary:** Provides for a referendum at the November 3, 2026, election to approve or reject an amendment to the Constitution of Virginia relating to the right to make one's own decisions related to reproductive health care, including access to abortion. The amendment protects patients and their doctors and nurses from being punished for making such decisions. The amendment allows the state to place restrictions on access to abortion during the third trimester of pregnancy except when the patient's life or physical or mental health is at risk or the pregnancy cannot survive.

**Fiscal Analysis:** The Department of Elections (ELECT) estimates the cost to meet the requirements of section 30-19.9 of the Code of Virginia, required ELECT to run advertisements in state newspapers and prepare posters and pamphlets providing public notice about statewide referendums. Based on current estimates the cost will be \$205,000.
