Bill Title: School access corridors; snow and ice removal; Planning District 8.

Bill Summary: Requires the Commissioner of Highways, when providing snow and ice removal services in Planning District 8, to prioritize the removal of snow and ice from certain state-maintained sidewalks and crosswalks defined in the bill as school access corridors.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No

Explanation: N/A

Fiscal Summary: The fiscal impact of this bill on the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) is indeterminate. Per VDOT, a study would need to be completed to identify the "school access corridors" for approximately 462 public schools in Planning District 8, to include walkshed areas, sidewalk ownership determinations and current agreements to tabulate total lane miles which would be prioritized. The costs of this study are indeterminate and would need to be redirected from other priorities. The operational impacts of the proposed requirement are also indeterminate.

Fiscal Analysis: None.

Other: Planning District 8 includes Loudoun, Prince William, Fairfax, and Arlington counties and the cities of Alexandria, Manassas, and Manassas Park.
