**Bill Number:** SB803

**Patron:** Deeds

**Bill Title:** Virginia Fair Housing Law; discriminatory housing practices; quid pro quo harassment.

**Bill Summary:** Adds quid pro quo harassment, defined in the bill, as a discriminatory housing practice under the Virginia Fair Housing Law.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**Items Impacted:** None

**Explanation:** This bill involves the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR); however, no budget action is needed.

**Fiscal Summary:** It is anticipated that any fiscal impact to DPOR can be absorbed within existing appropriation.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This bill defines “quid pro quo harassment” as a discriminatory housing practice in the context of real estate transactions.

This bill may increase the case load for the Fair Housing Board, however DPOR anticipates that any impact can be absorbed within existing appropriation.

Additionally, while the bill does not require action by the Real Estate Board, they may choose to communicate this change to regulant members or incorporate it into updated guidance. It is anticipated that any actions by the Real Estate Board can be completed through regularly scheduled meetings with existing resources.
