**Bill Number:** SB575S1 **Patron:** Reeves  
**Bill Title:** Virginia Public Procurement Act; joint and cooperative procurement; construction exception.

**Bill Summary:** Current law provides that a public body may purchase from another public body's contract or from the contract of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments or the Virginia Sheriffs' Association, even if it did not participate in the request for proposal or invitation to bid, if the request for proposal or invitation to bid specified that the procurement was a cooperative procurement being conducted on behalf of other public bodies with exceptions for architectural or engineering services or construction.

The substitute bill excludes intergovernmental support agreements entered into pursuant to 10 U.S.C. § 2679 from this provision.
