Bill Title: School boards; authority to prohibit sale of energy drinks to students in public high schools.

Bill Summary: Permits any school board to prohibit the sale of energy drinks, as defined in the bill, to students in public high schools in the local school division, regardless of whether any such drink meets the requirements to be considered a diet or low-calorie beverage under any relevant federal regulation.
