**Bill Title:** Virginia Consumer Protection Act; shipping goods without certain information.

**Bill Summary:** Provides that it is a prohibited practice under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act for a supplier to ship goods to a consumer in the Commonwealth without including a shipping invoice stating (i) the amount the consumer was charged for shipping, if any; (ii) information on how to return the goods, if returns are accepted by the supplier; and (iii) information on how to cancel the automatic renewal or continuous service offer. The provisions shall not apply to any supplier that provides a consumer the information required pursuant to clauses (i), (ii), and (iii) by a timely electronic confirmation of purchase or by otherwise making such information readily available.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**Explanation:** The Attorney General and Department of Law (OAG) is not expected to need additional resources to implement the proposed legislation.
