Bill Title: Foster and adoptive homes; barrier crimes; exceptions.

Bill Summary: Consolidates existing barrier crime exceptions for foster or adoptive homes, including kinship foster homes, and establishes new barrier crime exceptions for certain drug offenses.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No **Items Impacted:** n/a

Fiscal Summary: No fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis: The Department of Social Services (DSS) reports that this legislation aligns existing sections of the Code of Virginia pertaining to barrier crimes and barrier crime exceptions. The proposed updates to the Code are primarily technical in nature and bring the Code of Virginia into alignment with existing federal law. DSS reports that alignment of such Code sections does not change existing practice at DSS or local departments of social services; accordingly, no fiscal impact is expected.
