Bill Title: Programs for at-risk students; permissible uses of funding.

Bill Summary: Includes as covered programs that are eligible for funding under the At-Risk Program initiatives to support both the physical and mental health of students in public schools, including the hiring of registered nurses and advanced practice registered nurses. The bill is a recommendation of the School Health Services Committee.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No

Items Impacted: None

Explanation: There is no anticipated state fiscal impact as a result of the provisions of this bill. Any impact to local school divisions is indeterminate.

Fiscal Analysis: This bill expands the allowable uses by local school divisions to spend funding provided through Direct Aid to Public Education for the At- Risk Add-on. The bill does not change the calculation of funding, therefore there is no anticipated state fiscal impact.

Other: This bill is identical to SB33 as introduced.
