**Bill Title:** Local, regional, and community correctional facilities; access to counsel for inmates.

**Bill Summary:** The engrossed bill requires the State Board of Local and Regional Jails to establish additional standards no later than January 1, 2027, to ensure access to legal counsel for inmates held in any local, regional, or community correctional facility and enumerates the standards that the Board shall include in such additional standards. The engrossed bill removed the requirement for the standards to include a process by which counsel can submit complaints of noncompliance to the Board of Local and regional Jails and procedures for the Board to address such complaints.
