**Bill Number:** SB183S1                            **Patron:** Williams Graves  
**Bill Title:** Board of Health; restaurants; major food allergen labeling.

**Bill Summary:** Directs the Board of Health to promulgate regulations requiring all restaurants that provide delivery or carry out service to label items containing major food allergens.

As amended, the bill provides that the Board of Health shall establish standardized identifying markers for each common food allergy or sensitivity, to include each of the major food allergens specified in 12VAC5-421-10, as well as gluten.
