Bill Title: Department of Corrections; language services for offenders.

Bill Summary: The engrossed bill provides that the Department of Corrections shall take reasonable steps to provide offenders with limited English proficiency meaningful access to Department facilities, services, programs, and activities to ensure that language does not prevent Department employees from communicating effectively with such offenders. The engrossed bill removes the use of sign language as consideration for an offender to have limited English proficiency.
