State Fiscal Impact Statement

Fiscal Analysis: The primary impact of this bill involves the cost associated with adding two members to the Commission. It is estimated member compensation will be approximately \$2,400 for two additional members attending four meetings per year, the average number of meetings a commission of this nature usually involves and will be paid by the office of the Clerk of the Senate. The travel expenses are expected to be \$3,176 for the two Senate members, and will be paid for by the Commission. Compensation and travel reimbursement are subject to Joint Rules approval per § 30-202.

This bill also eliminates the Virginia Coal and Energy Commission. Currently, \$21,629 is provided in Item 1 for the Virginia Coal and Energy Commission.
