**Fiscal Analysis:** Allowing licensees to have their food requirements satisfied through customers bringing in their own food would be a requirement that has not existed before for ABC. ABC anticipates having to hire two additional compliance agents to regulate and enforce these requirements, and one license tech to provide administrative support for additional agents and new licensee requirements.
