Bill Title: Nonemergency medical transportation providers; fee disclosure.

Bill Summary: Requires a nonemergency medical transportation provider, prior to providing such transportation services to a patient, to provide the patient or the patient's representative with a written disclosure of all associated fees or other charges for which the patient will be responsible for such transportation services. The provisions of this bill shall be effective on January 1, 2027.

Additionally, the Department of Health (VDH) shall develop and publish on its website a standardized form for disclosure of fees by nonemergency medical transportation providers that satisfies the requirements of this bill by October 1, 2026.

Fiscal Summary: This bill has a minimal fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis: The Department of Medical Assistance Services indicates that this bill has no fiscal impact on the agency. The bill, as substituted, explicitly excludes services provided through the state plan of medical assistance.

VDH may have a minimal fiscal impact to develop and publish a standardized form for disclosure of fees, as required by the third enactment of the bill.
