Bill Title: Adult adoptees; access to vital records.

Bill Summary: Requires the State Registrar to provide adult adoptees access to their birth certificate upon request. The bill directs the State Registrar to make a contact preference form available to birth parents that allows them to indicate their preference for contact by the adopted person. Such form is stored with the adopted person's birth certificate and provided upon the adopted person's request of the birth certificate.

As amended, the bill requires adult adoptees requesting a copy of their birth certificate to submit an application, proof of identification, and payment to the State Registrar.

Fiscal Summary: Minimal fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis: Any increase in workload to create a contact preference form and receive applications is expected to be minimal and can be supported with fee revenue.
