Bill Title: Limitation on prosecution of felony due to lapse of time after finding of probable cause; misdemeanors; exceptions; retaining counsel.

Bill Summary: This substitute provides that the trial court shall conduct, no more than 30 days apart, reviews of the accused's attorney status. Tolling of speedy trial pursuant to this subdivision shall end when the accused has either retained counsel or had counsel appointed to him and such counsel has entered an appearance in the case or the accused executes a valid waiver of counsel.
