Bill Title: Retired law-enforcement officers; emergency and temporary detention admissions.

Bill Summary: Clarifies that the term "law-enforcement officer" as used in relevant law relating to emergency and involuntary civil admissions includes retired law-enforcement officers, defined in the bill, for the purposes of laws related to emergency custody and involuntary temporary detention.
