WHEREAS, working with the horse PPF A Summer's Song, also known as "Sunny," Alice Barlow notably had top 10 finishes in 15 of the 16 classes in which she competed, including her championships in classes within the western, English, trail, halter, and dressage divisions; and

WHEREAS, Alice Barlow is qualified to judge multiple breeds of horses, and she has supported the equestrian community by serving as a judge at competitions across the country; and

WHEREAS, Alice Barlow's accomplishments are the result of her exceptional horse-riding knowledge and experience, her tireless training, and her unwavering commitment to excellence; now, therefore, be it
