Bill Title: Law-enforcement officers; enforcement of federal immigration law; restrictions.

Bill Summary: Prohibits a law-enforcement officer acting in his capacity as a law-enforcement officer or an employee of a law-enforcement agency shall assist, cooperate with, or use any law-enforcement resources to facilitate any operation to identify, arrest, or otherwise impose a penalty upon any individual for purposes of federal immigration enforcement. The bill provides that such prohibition shall not apply if such person is presented with a valid judicial warrant or judicial subpoena, or if otherwise required by federal law. The bill also establishes the provisions any federal immigration enforcement agreement must include.
