**Bill Title:** School bus video-monitoring systems; enforcement; sworn or affirmed certificates.

**Bill Summary:** Authorizes, for enforcement of violations related to passing a stopped school bus via video-monitoring system, the use of a certificate, or a facsimile thereof, sworn to or affirmed by a law-enforcement officer or a retired sworn law-enforcement officer, as defined in the bill, based on recorded images produced by the video-monitoring system as prima facie evidence of the facts contained therein.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** Indeterminate

**Items Impacted:** None

**Explanation:** Not applicable

**Fiscal Summary:** The impact on state and local law enforcement is indeterminate at this time.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This bill proposes that if a video-monitoring system is used to provide evidence of a violation relating to passing a stopped school bus, proof of such violation of this section will be evidenced by information obtained from such device that has been affirmed by a law-enforcement officer or a retired sworn law-enforcement officer via a certificate or a facsimile thereof, and such certificate or facsimile thereof will serve as prima facie evidence of the facts contained therein.

The impact on state and local law enforcement is indeterminate at this time.
