Bill Title: Overdose fatality review teams; suicide deaths of veterans and military service members

Bill Summary: As amended, provides that any county or city, or combination of counties, cities, or counties and cities, may establish a local or regional suicide fatality review team for the purpose of (i) conducting contemporaneous reviews of local deaths from suicide, including suicide deaths of military service members and veterans; (ii) promoting cooperation and coordination among agencies involved in investigations of suicide deaths, including suicide deaths of military service members and veterans, or in providing services to surviving family members; (iii) developing an understanding of the causes and incidence of suicide deaths in the locality; (iv) developing plans for and recommending changes within the agencies represented on the local team to prevent suicide deaths; and (v) advising the Department and other relevant state agencies on changes to law, policy, or practice to prevent suicide deaths.
