Bill Title: Law-enforcement agencies; agreements with federal authority for immigration enforcement; requirements.

Bill Summary: Prohibits any state or local law-enforcement agency from maintaining, renewing, or entering into any federal immigration law-enforcement agreement unless such agreement contains certain conditions. The bill also prohibits any person acting in his capacity as a law-enforcement officer to assist or cooperate with or to allow or authorize any resources to assist or cooperate with or to otherwise to facilitate any operation that seeks to identify, arrest, or otherwise impose a penalty upon an individual for purposes of federal civil immigration enforcement. The bill provides that such prohibition shall not apply where unless presented with a valid judicial warrant, judicial subpoena, or if otherwise required by federal law.
