**Bill Title:** Continuing care providers; quarterly meeting requirements

**Bill Summary:** The substitute bill provides that representatives elected by the residents of a continuing care facility must have the right to meet at least annually with the chief executive officer or his designee and a member of the board of directors or other such governing body of a continuing care facility, other than a member who is an employee or officer of the provider, for the purpose of free discussion of issues relating to the facility. These issues may include income, expenditures, and financial matters as they apply to the facility and proposed changes in policies, programs, facilities, and services. Residents must be entitled to seven days' notice of each such meeting.
