percent of the Virginia National Guard's FY2025 budget and any reduction would impact agency operations. In addition, according to DMA, the provisions of the bill associated with prohibiting out-of-state militias to enter the Commonwealth without permission from the Governor may reduce the amount of non-federal nongeneral fund revenues generated annually. DMA reports that non-federal nongeneral fund revenues are generated through fees charged to out-of-state militias that come to Fort Pickett in Blackstone, Virginia for training purposes. This revenue has primarily been used by the agency to cover costs associated with the maintenance and upkeep of barracks, facilities, and training areas on Fort Pickett. According to DMA, a loss or reduction of nongeneral fund revenue would impact the agency's ability to fund maintenance and operational costs at Fort Pickett. However, there is not enough information available to reliably calculate an estimate on the reduction of both federal and non-federal nongeneral funds, and therefore the fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate.
