

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 9.1-116.1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by*  
 3 *adding a section numbered 17.1-275.15, relating to Virginia Sexual and Domestic Violence Victim Fund;*  
 4 *additional fee for certain offenses.*

7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**8 **1. That § 9.1-116.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is**  
 9 **amended by adding a section numbered 17.1-275.15 as follows:**10 **§ 9.1-116.1. Virginia Sexual and Domestic Violence Victim Fund; purpose; guidelines.**11 A. There is created the Virginia Sexual and Domestic Violence Victim Fund (*the Fund*) as a special  
 12 nonreverting fund to be administered by the Department of Criminal Justice Services to support the  
 13 prosecution of domestic violence cases, *human and sex trafficking cases, criminal sexual assault cases,* and  
 14 victim services.15 B. The Department shall adopt guidelines, the purpose of which shall be to make funds available to (i)  
 16 local attorneys for the Commonwealth for the purpose of funding the cost of additional attorneys or to further  
 17 dedicate existing resources to prosecute felonies and misdemeanors involving domestic violence, sexual  
 18 violence, sexual abuse, stalking, ~~and~~ family abuse, *and human and sex trafficking*; (ii) law-enforcement  
 19 authorities or appropriate programs, including civil legal assistance *and local child advocacy organizations,*  
 20 to assist in protecting and providing necessary services to victims of and children affected by domestic  
 21 violence, sexual abuse, stalking, ~~and~~ family abuse, *and human and sex trafficking*; and (iii) sexual assault  
 22 service providers and hospitals for the purpose of funding the cost of salaries and equipment for sexual  
 23 assault forensic examiners, *forensic nurse examiners who provide services for eligible cases and victims,*  
 24 sexual assault nurse examiners, and pediatric sexual assault nurse examiners, with priority for funding such  
 25 costs given to such forensic examiners and nurse examiners serving rural or underserved areas of the  
 26 Commonwealth.27 C. A portion of the sum collected pursuant to § 16.1-69.48:1 as specified in that section shall be deposited  
 28 into the state treasury to the credit of ~~this~~ *the* Fund in addition to any other moneys appropriated, allocated, or  
 29 received specifically for such purpose. The Fund shall be distributed according to grant procedures adopted  
 30 pursuant to this section and shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. Any funds remaining in  
 31 ~~such~~ *the* Fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund.  
 32 Interest earned on the Fund shall be credited to the Fund.33 D. *The fees collected pursuant to § 17.1-275.15 as specified in that section shall be deposited into the*  
 34 *state treasury to the credit of the Fund and shall be designated for funding support services for eligible*  
 35 *victims.*

36 E. The Department shall establish a grant procedure to govern funds awarded for this purpose.

37 **§ 17.1-275.15. Additional fee assessed for Virginia Sexual and Domestic Violence Victim Fund.**38 A. *In addition to the fees provided for by §§ 16.1-69.48:1, 16.1-69.48:1.01, 17.1-275.1, 17.1-275.2,*  
 39 *17.1-275.3, 17.1-275.4, 17.1-275.5, 17.1-275.7, 17.1-275.8, 17.1-275.9, 17.1-275.10, 17.1-275.11, and*  
 40 *17.1-275.12, a fee of \$500 upon conviction of any and each charge of a violation of (i) §§ 18.2-47 and*  
 41 *18.2-48; (ii) Article 7 (§ 18.2-61 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 18.2; or (iii) §§ 18.2-346.01 through*  
 42 *18.2-357.1, 18.2-366, 18.2-370 through 18.2-370.6, 18.2-374.1, 18.2-374.1:1, and 18.2-374.3 shall be*  
 43 *assessed as court costs.*44 B. *All fees collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the state treasury, credited to the*  
 45 *Virginia Sexual and Domestic Violence Victim Fund, and designated for funding support services for eligible*  
 46 *victims.*
