Bill Title: Consumer Data Protection Act; data controller responsibilities; precise geolocation data.

Bill Summary: Provides that, for purposes of the Consumer Data Protection Act, a controller of personal data shall not sell or offer for sale precise geolocation data concerning a consumer.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

Items Impacted: None.

Explanation: The legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact for the Office of the Attorney General and Department of Law (OAG). An amendment removes the provision that requires a controller that violates any provision of this subsection shall be subject to investigation and enforcement by the Attorney General as described in this chapter.

Fiscal Summary: The legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.

Fiscal Analysis: The House amendment removes the provision requiring a controller to be subject to investigation and enforcement by the OAG.
