**Bill Title:** Voluntary contributions during electronic Department of Motor Vehicles transactions.

**Bill Summary:** Requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to provide a method by which an individual conducting certain electronic Department transactions may make a voluntary contribution to the Virginia Highway Safety Improvement Program. Under current law, the Department is only required to provide a method by which voluntary contributions may be made to the Virginia Donor Registry and Public Awareness Fund.

**Explanation:** N/A

**Fiscal Summary:** Any anticipated state fiscal impact related to implementation costs associated with this bill are expected to be absorbed within existing resources.

**Fiscal Analysis:** The Department of Motor Vehicles anticipates some costs associated with implementation of this bill, but these costs can be absorbed through the normal course of business operations.
