Bill Title: Motor vehicles; emissions; glass repair and replacement; penalties.

Bill Summary: Establishes various notice requirements for motor vehicle glass repair shops, defined in the bill, and provides that a violation of such requirements is a prohibited practice under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act. The bill permits a motor vehicle to qualify for an emissions inspection waiver if such vehicle has failed an inspection and the vehicle's onboard diagnostic system is in a not-ready condition to be tested when presented for reinspection.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

Items Impacted: None.

Explanation: The Office of the Attorney General and Department of Law (OAG) is not expected to need additional resources to implement the proposed legislation.

Fiscal Summary: The OAG is expected to implement the proposed legislation within its operating budget.

Fiscal Analysis: The bill would not require additional funding for the OAG.

Other: This bill is a companion to HB 312-S1.
