The bill directs Energy to conduct an open request for proposals for such consulting services, publish the results, and solicit voluntary private funding to cover all costs of consulting contracts related to this study.

The bill also directs Energy and SCC to perform additional analysis of potential regulatory pathways to support financing of the recommendations.

Amendments to SB 30 passed by the Senate include \$1.0 million in FY 2027 and \$425,000 in FY 2028 for the combined implementation of this bill and four others impacting Energy.
