The bill establishes a workgroup should include a representative of the Virginia Association of Commonwealth's Attorneys, the Executive Director of the Virginia Indigent Defense Commission or his designee, the Executive Director of the Virginia State Crime Commission or his designee, the Director of the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services or his designee, the Director of the Virginia Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation or his designee, the Superintendent of Public Instruction or his designee, a representative from the Virginia Association of School Superintendents, the Director of the Department of Health Professions or his designee, the Commissioner of the Department of Social Services or his designee, the Director of the Department of Human Resource Management or his designee, a member of the staff of the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations, a member of the staff of the House Committee on Appropriations, and any other relevant stakeholders and reports its findings by December 1, 2026.

Participation in workgroup is not expected to have a material fiscal impact on the Virginia Indigent Defense Commission, Virginia State Crime Commission, Department of Criminal Justice Services, Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, Department of Education, Department of Health Professions, Department of Social Services, and Department of Human Resource Management
