Bill Title: School boards; participation in SAT School Day program required; student participation.

Bill Summary: Requires each local school board to (i) participate in the SAT School Day program or any similar program offered by the College Board whereby high school students are permitted to take the SAT during regular school hours at the high school in which they are enrolled and (ii) offer each high school student in the school division the opportunity to take the SAT pursuant to the program at least once during the student's junior or senior year in either the fall or spring testing window at the public high school at which the student is enrolled, provided that (a) no such student shall be required to participate in the program, and (b) if offered during the fall testing window, the school board shall, to the extent feasible, align the day on which it offers such opportunity with the PSAT testing window.
