**Bill Title:** Enforcement of federal traffic infractions by state and local law-enforcement officers;  
Planning District 8.

**Bill Summary:** Provides that state and local law-enforcement officers may enforce federal traffic infractions on any highway within Planning District 8. The bill requires the uniform traffic summons form to be updated to reference both the newly proposed § 46.2-102.1 and the incorporated state statute, local ordinance, or federal statute or regulation.
