SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 2006

Celebrating the life of Louis A. Boone.

Agreed to by the Senate, April 23, 2026

WHEREAS, a freshman at Norfolk State University (NSU), Louis Boone was majoring in mass communications and broadcast and served as a photographer on the university newspaper, the *Spartan Echo*, where he was admired for his work ethic, eagerness to learn, and positive spirit; and

WHEREAS, Louis Boone was a member of the NSU Chapter of the National Association of Black Journalists and the NSU Content Creator Club; he also volunteered with the WNSB Hot 91.1 FM radio station; and

WHEREAS, Louis Boone will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by numerous family members and friends; and

WHEREAS, the NSU community will remember and celebrate the life of Louis Boone, whose spirit will forever echo through the halls of his beloved institution, where generations of Spartans will continue to “Behold the Green and Gold” and carry forward his legacy of pride, perseverance, and enduring impact; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of Virginia hereby note with great sadness the loss of Louis A. Boone, a beloved resident of Dumfries and a promising student at Norfolk State University; and, be it
