3. Committee: Judiciary

4. Title: Misdemeanor; maximum term of confinement.

5. Summary: Under current law, Class 1 misdemeanor convictions are punishable by confinement in jail for not more than twelve months and a fine of not more than \$2,500, either or both. This bill reduces the term of incarceration to 364 days. The bill contains technical amendments.
