SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 633

Celebrating the life of Jeffrey L. Newton.

Agreed to by the Senate, July 18, 2024

WHEREAS, Jeffrey L. Newton, a dedicated law-enforcement officer, respected leader in the Patawomeck Indian Tribe of Virginia, and devoted husband, father, grandfather, and friend in the White Oak area of Stafford County, died on May 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Newton dedicated 43 years of service to the Stafford County Sheriff's Office and was an important source of institutional knowledge in the department, as well as a trusted friend to his colleagues and a mentor to younger officers; and

WHEREAS, highly admired for his professionalism and humility, Jeffrey Newton cultivated strong bonds of mutual respect and understanding between the Stafford County Sheriff's Office and members of the public; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Newton was proud of his Native American heritage and provided his wise insights and counsel to the Patawomeck Indian Tribe of Virginia as a tribal judge; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Newton's unique life experiences and deep knowledge of the people, places, and history of Stafford County helped him build bridges between communities and enhance the quality of life for all residents; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Newton will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife, Judy; his sons, Jeffrey, Jr., Matthew, and William, and their families; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of Virginia hereby note with great sadness the loss of Jeffrey L. Newton, a highly admired member of the Stafford County community; and, be it
