6 WHEREAS, Walter Williams Scott, a financial professional, dedicated community leader, and
7 beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend in Richmond, died on December 9, 2023; and

8 WHEREAS, a native of Richmond, Walter Scott earned a bachelor's degree and a master of business
9 administration degree from the University of Virginia, then pursued a long and distinguished career in
10 banking; and

11 WHEREAS, Walter Scott worked at banks in the Richmond area and was a board member of the
12 Gloucester Banks Association; and

13 WHEREAS, outside of his career, Walter Scott was deeply devoted to Troop 400 of the Boy Scouts
14 of America, serving as the longtime treasurer, managing fundraisers, and cooking meals for hikes,
15 among other contributions; in 2001, he received the Silver Beaver Award for his exceptional volunteer
16 service; and

17 WHEREAS, Walter Scott also provided his leadership and expertise to the Custis Fishing and
18 Hunting Club, Chippokes Plantation Farm Foundation, Richmond Community High School, and other
19 organizations; and

20 WHEREAS, a true renaissance man who lived by the Scout motto "Be Prepared," Walter Scott was
21 generous with his time and talents and was always ready to help a friend in need, no matter the
22 occasion; and

23 WHEREAS, Walter Scott enjoyed fellowship and worship with the community as a member of St.
24 Paul's Episcopal Church, where he was a member of the vestry and chaired a lunch program during Lent
25 for many years; and

26 WHEREAS, predeceased by his wife, Vaughan, and his sons, John and Walter, Jr., Walter Scott will
27 be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his daughter, Mary; his children's families, including four
28 grandchildren; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

29 RESOLVED, That the House of Delegates hereby note with great sadness the loss of Walter
30 Williams Scott; and, be it
