3. **Committee:** Rules

4. **Title:** Unpaved secondary highway funds; improvements; report.

5. **Summary:** Provides that improvements to nonsurface treated secondary highways may, at the discretion of the locality, include changes other than paving, including enhanced maintenance and capital improvements to such highway. The bill directs the Department of Transportation to review and consider methods of improving unpaved secondary highways other than paving such highways and report its findings and recommendations to the Chairs of the House and Senate Committees on Transportation by November 1, 2024.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this will not have a state fiscal impact to the Virginia Department of Transportation.

11. **Other Comments:** HB74 and SB644 also address that the improvement of nonsurface treated secondary highways can include improvements other than paving.
